





# Thou shalt not take the Name of יהוה thy Elohiym in vain...

## The Falling Away (2 Thes. 2:3-12)

1500 BC – 70AD\* ..... 3<sup>rd</sup> AD..... 14<sup>th</sup> AD..... 2010

The origin of this Name is [Ibry] or Hebrew. It is found in the oldest Hebrew texts like the dead sea scrolls which date back to early BC. This is the very Name that the Most High wrote with His finger on tablets of stone and gave to Mosheh. There are three parts to Our Father's Name. First "HAYAH" from Hebrew SL #1961 is translated יהי "I AM" and means to exist, to be, was, which is similar to "Yahh" in #3050. Then "HU" from Hebrew SL #1931 means that, who, which, or he. Lastly, "HAYAH" means to be, to exist, and is translated as "I AM". יהוה [YAHUAH] "I AM THAT I AM" also means "Who was, Who is, Who is to come." His Name can be seen in Hebrew SL #3068, but with a different pronunciation. There are also 100 servants and prophets that bare the testimony of His Name in their own names. [He Exists] for certain.

[YaHWeH] is a false name of the original Name. Many scholars have assumed this to be the pronunciation of The Name. This is the biggest rival against The True Name. However the transliteration of this name has no scriptural backing. The name has connections with the false Roman elohiym Jupiter (JOVE), which is connected to Zeus. The name is simply Satan hiding behind a mask, and is a teaching of a demon. [YaHWeH] seems to be one of the oldest rendering of The Name, therefore many assume it to be correct, but it also breaks the 3<sup>rd</sup> commandment and users will be punished.

This is a variant of the Qodesh Name from Hebrew SL #3068. יהי "YaH" is translated as "I AM". The "hovah" portion of the name seen in Hebrew SL #1943 means "ruin" or "disaster". Thus this name breaks the 3<sup>rd</sup> commandment, and takes The Most High's Name in vain. He states that He will punish anyone who takes His Name in vain, which means to dilute or bring down to nothing. Also according to Rev 22:19, He will also take away that person's part from the tree of life.

[YeHoWaH] is close, but it is inaccurate. Upon further inspection of the name we notice that the "yod" and the "hey" make a "Yeh" sound instead of a "Yah" sound. As earlier stated, יהי "YaH" is translated as "I AM". Truth tells us that the Masorites used vowel pointing system that was not apart of the pure Hebrew language. So this name covers up the Creator's Name, and takes it in vain. This name is simply void and means nothing. People who use this name participate in works of darkest that has tried to blot out our Father's Name.

[Jehovah] is a recent false hybrid form of the true Name. It started with a Spanish monks mistake in year 1270. Then in William Tyndale's version its seen as "Iehouah". Later in the 1611 King James version it appeared as "Iehovah" before the English language acquired the "J". We know this is not the Name simply because there is no "J" sound in Hebrew. This name is simply a creation do to mistransliteration. The name means disaster, and that's just what users of this name may face if there is no repentance.

The Hebrew word [Adonai] stems back to the biggest conspiracy in human history. Almost 7,000 times the Most High's Name was taken out of His Word!!!! So the scribes replaced יהוה with the name of the devil. Ba'al is a ancient deity of weather, fertility, or the supreme male divinity of the Canaanites. In Hebrew SL #1168 we can see the "lord" "Ba'al" connection. There are other false elohiym that carry the name of Ba'al. For example, Ba'al Zebub is a demon and refers to the Prince of demons, referring to Satan himself. יהושע said that they would call Him this. Hence words like The Messiah is "Lord" and words like "Lord God".
